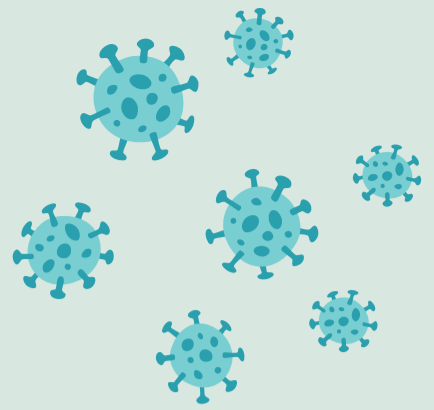

Information about Corona vaccination in Drammen Kommune

The spread of COVID-19 is on the increase both in Norway and Drammen, especially among children, youngsters and young adults. It is therefore still vital that we reduce the spread of the virus to avoid disease and death.

Those patients now suffering from COVID-19 in hospitals are mainly elderly fully vaccinated and unvaccinated adults.

The best way of reducing the spread is by vaccinating. The Corona vaccine is free of charge in Norway. You don't need a Norwegian ID-number or d-number to get the vaccine; your date of birth and name are enough.

All those over the age of twelve can now get the Corona vaccine in Norway.

The advantages of getting the Corona vaccine:

- Protection from serious illness and death for yourself if you become infected
- Reducing the risk of infecting others
- The Corona certificate

Most of the side-effects are harmless and disappear after a short time. The risk of complications if you get the COVID-19 disease, however, seem to be much greater than the risk of serious complications as a result of getting the vaccine.

Practical information:

In Drammen we vaccinate at Gulskogen Senter, and the vaccination station is open Monday to Friday from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. (11.00–17.00)

We use the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines every day.

There is drop-in vaccinations for doses 1 and 2, and also the 3rd dose (booster) for people with severe vulnerable conditions. To make an appointment just call 32 04 40 00.
